Instructions and Rules:

- 1) Entries will only be accepted to the individual class emails or Marlin Orchards (masks, posters, quilt squares) from Monday, August 10<sup>th</sup>, 2020 to Saturday, August 15<sup>th</sup>, 2020 by 5:00 PM.** Winners will be announced Online on Friday, August 21<sup>st</sup>, 2020. For the Children's Colouring Contest, partnered with the Glengarry, Nor' Westers & Loyalist Museum and the Flowers Cornwall competition, please see the specific instructions as the drop off is different than the above.
- 2) There are no exhibitors' fees. There are no traditional prizes. Prizes include donations by Home and Garden local partners: Marlin Orchards, Flowers Cornwall and Glengarry, Nor' Westers & Loyalist Museum.
- 3) You may enter ONE ITEM in each SECTION, but you may enter all sections; i.e., if you wish, you may enter every section in a class, and you may enter as many classes as you wish. Each item may be entered only ONCE and MAY NOT BE RE-ENTERED IN SUBSEQUENT YEARS.

- 4) Items to be handed in are **DONATED**. This means they will not be returned. They must be entered in a clear Ziplock bag with your Class (ex. Class 1, Cat 1), Name, Address, Phone Number or Email & Age if required attached to the back.
- 5) Emailed submissions require in the subject line the Class (ex. Class 1, Cat 1). Within the email include your Name, Address and Phone Number & Age if required. **PLEASE ENSURE YOU HAVE THE CORRECT EMAIL FOR THE CLASS.**
- 6) Judges will be selected from our own Home & Garden Directors that are not participating in the intake of the items/emails for fairness and confidentiality.
- 7) Photos and Videos may be shared on social media, local newspapers and the Williamstown Fair website. **Please do not submit something if you would not like it shared.**

**We recognize that not all classes could continue the same way this Fair season. We will continue next year with the 2021 Home & Garden Division classes and categories as originally printed earlier this year. Please keep your items safely tucked away and ready to be exhibited in 2021.**

*Exhibiting Tips: All vegetables must be homegrown.*

## Category 1 ~ **A COLLECTION**

A collection (minimum 5) of homegrown, freshly picked vegetables, fruit and/or herbs arranged in a container of your choice.

## Category 2 ~ **SUPER GARDENER TO THE RESCUE**

A homegrown, odd shaped vegetable or fruit; decorated and named.

*Theme: Superheroes of 2020.*

## Category 3 ~ **RAISED BED**

A photograph of your homemade, raised garden bed in all its' glory!

*Exhibiting Tips: Dead and damaged flowers and leaves should be removed. Entries should be free of insects and disease. No artificial flowers please. Judging will be based on colour, design, texture and overall condition of plant(s).*

### **Category 1 ~ WINDOW BOX, PLANTER OR GARDEN CONTAINER**

Arranged and planted by exhibitor. Exhibitor may only enter one of the items.

### **Category 2 ~ "COVID HEROES" HANGING BASKET**

Arranged and planted by exhibitor. Take two photos of your entry. One picture is to show the overall appearance and the second picture is to show a close-up of the plant(s).

### **Category 2 ~ CAKE DECORATION (Children 12 and under)**

Decorate a cake or a combination of cupcakes with the theme of “Superheroes of 2020”. Submissions will be in the form of photographs so will be judged purely on appearance. Judges will be focusing on attractiveness and creativity.

### **Category 3 ~ BAKING VIDEO**

Create a video in any style you would like of you baking an item of your choosing. Video must be condensed to 2 min or less. Judging will be based both on the process/final product of the baked good and the entertainment level of the video/cooking show.
